In 1488 they received a grant of arms. The Bowyers were granted a charter on 25 May 1621; ordinances were granted in 1670. The company had a hall in Noble Street until the 1630s. The archives were deposited in the Library in 1949 and 2001, and were catalogued by various members of staff over many years. The records were compiled from 1679, but they include copies of earlier material from 1625. Ms 32812/2-4 are subject to a 30-year closure period. As the archive is large and complex, and to assist the user, the catalogue has been arranged in sections each with an archive classification code as follows: LBEB Constitutional records. LBEB Court records. LBEB Membership records. LBEB Financial records. LBEB Trade records. LBEB Clerk's records. LBEB Charities and estates. Entering the appropriate code in a Number Search will bring up summary details of all records in that section in archival order.
